Janet Malser was a lifelong resident of Dudley and Webster, Massachusetts. She established this Trust so that the causes she was involved with would continue to be supported when she was no longer with us. Her love of art, history, rature, and music inspired her to champion causes related to the arts and humanities, community service, and conservation. Through this Trust, Janet's generosity of "self" will continue to be realized for years to come. This is her legacy.

The Janet Malser Humanities Trust was established in 2009 as a 501(c)(3) charitable foundation. Its purpose is to fund educational, cultural, historic, and charitable causes in the towns of Dudley, Oxford, or Webster, Massachusetts.

AWARD AMOUNTS: Grants may range from \$500-\$50,000 and will be awarded annually.

ELIGIBILITY: The Janet Malser Humanities Trust provides grants only to duly recognized, not-for-profit, tax-exempt organizations. The Malser Trust will consider requests from organizations

tax-exempt organizations. The Malser Trust will consider requests from organizations that are based in or will directly benefit residents in the towns of Dudley, Oxford, or Webster.

DEADLINE: April 1, 2025

Applications must be postmarked no later than the deadline date. Late applications

will not be considered for review.

The Janet Malser Trust provides funding for certain causes limited to the geographic area that includes only the towns of Dudley, Oxford, or Webster, in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

The causes for which funding may be considered are:
