Final Grant Report

It is *required of every grant recipient to deliver a final report to the Janet Malser Trust upon completion of their project. Failure to file a report based on the guidelines below, before the next grant cycle, will jeopardize any future funding for that applicant.

The report must include:

- A written narrative describing the outcome of the project.
- An outline of expenditures.
 - A. Supporting documentation, i.e., copies of:
 - 1. Bills
 - 2. Receipts

*If a project is not completed by the end of the granted funding cycle, then that recipient should notify the Trust with a written explanation/description of the progress to date. If this report is not received, this will jeopardize any future consideration for funding.
